

Master Bedroom

Our client asked us to transform what they described as their cluttered sleeping quarters into a peaceful bedroom with plenty of storage. They were open minded as far as colour scheme was concerned but keen to incorporate duck egg blue somewhere in the scheme. The wardrobes were designed to offer a combination of long and short hanging space as well as integral drawer storage. Taking the wardrobes deeper than the alcoves either side of the chimney breast afforded us the space for a built in headboard and recessed bookcases with integral LED reading lights.

The silk stripe in the cushions brings the whole scheme together picking up the fair shades of the sycamore plus the yew wood detail on the headboard and blending calmly with Farrow & Ball's Borrowed Light which we used for the walls. The silk, interlined curtains add a certain luxury and the duck egg mohair throw a contrasting texture as well as fabulous winter warmth.
